The insurance policy for Civic Regalia is not an exhaustive list of perils covered, but instead states that the Regalia is not covered for consequential loss or pollution and contamination.

In relation to your request for a copy of the Police report used in conjunction with the claim for the Mayoral Chain, and a copy of the Insurer’s response to the claim, this information is exempt under the Freedom of Information Act 2015 as it relates to information held prior to 11th October 2011.
