The Director of Environment and Regeneration (as acting Chief Executive), Director of Housing and Property and the Assistant Chief Officer (Income) were in attendance.

Apologies for absence were submitted by Mr Councillor A.J. Bentley and the Chief Executive.

#### 1. One Minute Silence

The Council stood to observe a one-minute silence for former Member of the Council, Mr Eddie Joyce who had sadly passed away since the last meeting.

#### 2. **Minutes – 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2024**

The minutes of the monthly Council meeting held on Wednesday, 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2024, were approved and signed.

#### 3. Standing Order 39 – Question – Mr Councillor J.E. Skinner

Mr Councillor J.E. Skinner asked the Vice-Chair of the Regeneration and Community Committee:

How many times in each of the last five Financial Years has the football pitch in Nobles Park been hired out to football clubs or other bodies, and what income has been derived from this in each of these years?

Reply by the Vice-Chair of the Regeneration and Community Committee:

Oct 17-Jun 18	10 times	£1,532
Sep 18-May 19	10 times	£1,619
Oct 19-Apr 20	7 times	£1,110
Sep 20-Aug 21	10 times	£1,583
Sep 21-Jun 22	3 times	£195
Feb 24-Jun 24	5 times	£1,004

Figures reflect the football seasons rather than financial years.

Some seasons were disrupted by Covid. One season (22/23) was disrupted due to the TT temporary roadway exiting the church over the pitch (since written out of the TT licence). In 2023/24, Governors Athletic moved temporarily to Nobles Park Pitch after Christmas (only half a season).

# 4. Standing Order 39 – Question – Mr Councillor J.E. Skinner

Mr Councillor J.E. Skinner asked the Vice-Chair of the Regeneration and Community Committee:

On how many occasions (dates and times) during the 2024 TT period did Council Officers attend Nobles Park to ensure that conditions of the Licence issued to the Department of Enterprise and the TT Organisers were being complied with?

Reply by the Vice-Chair of the Regeneration and Community Committee:

Parks Management attended two formal meetings at the beginning and end of the official handover of the TT areas on 6<sup>th</sup> May (10am) and 25<sup>th</sup> June (2pm). Between then, on site staff monitored and would alert management as necessary. This year, as no issues were identified relating to the Department for Enterprise, no further meetings were required.

## 5. Standing Order 39 – Question – Mr Councillor J.E. Skinner

Mr Councillor J.E. Skinner asked the Leader of the Council:

Given the current high numbers of domestic abuse incidents reported to the Police over the last twelve months, what is the Council doing to help and assist the victims of these crimes?

Reply by the Leader of the Council:

There are no further comments that can be added to the response given to the private written question in January 2024. The views of other authorities have been sought and feedback will be given to Members in due Course.

#### 6. Standing Order 39 – Question – Mr Councillor J.E. Skinner

Mr Councillor J.E. Skinner asked the Leader of the Council:

In the interest of openness and transparency, are the Minutes of Local Authority CEO / Clerks meetings (Clerk's Forums) available for the elected members and the public to view and if so, where can these be found?

Reply by Leader of the Council:

The Department of Infrastructure oversees and records the notes of the Clerk's forum which includes officers from various Local Authorities. It is not normal practice to publish officer level meeting notes and they are therefore not available for public inspection.
