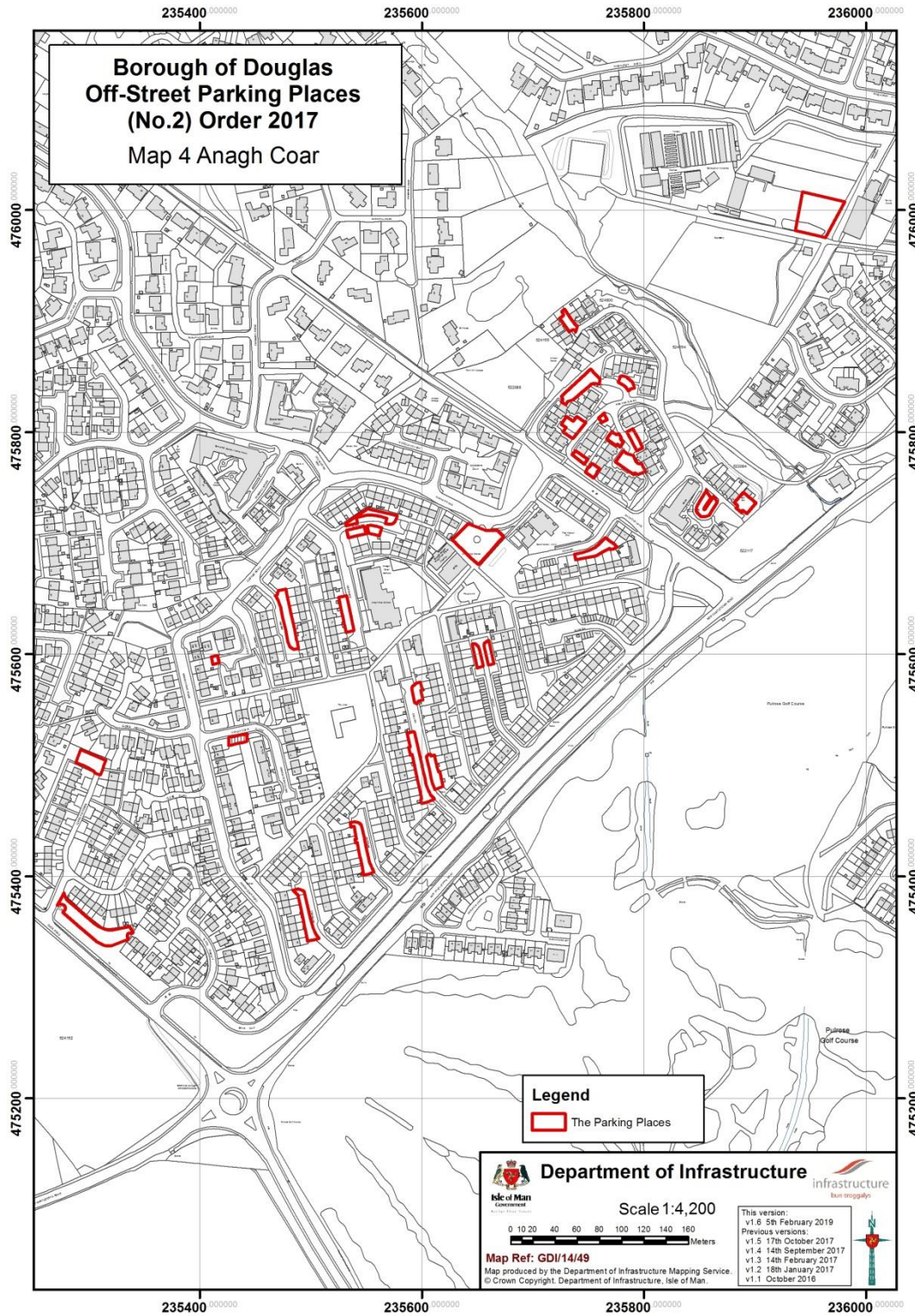
#### 1 Article 3 amended

In article 3 (interpretation) —

- (a) in the definition of “additional parking charge”, for “article 10” substitute ~~“article 9”~~ article 9 ~~“”~~;
- (b) after the definition of “driver” insert —  
| ~~“”~~ **“electric vehicle”** means an all-electric vehicle or a plug-in hybrid electric vehicle; ~~“”~~;
- (c) after the definition of “motor caravan” insert —  
| ~~“”~~ **“non-electric vehicle”** means an all-petroleum vehicle or a regular hybrid electric vehicle; ~~“”~~;
- (d) in the definition of “parking place”, for “article 9(1)” substitute ~~“article 10(1)”~~ ~~“”~~; and
- (e) in the definition of “permitted vehicle”, for “article 9(1)” substitute ~~“article 10(1)”~~ ~~“”~~.

**66**(5) A driver of a permitted vehicle must not cause the vehicle to wait in a parking place listed in paragraph (1)(a) to (k) or (n) for longer than 3 months. **67**.

*EXPLANATORY NOTE*

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends the Borough of Douglas Off-Street Parking Places (No.2) Order 2017<sup>4</sup> (“2017 Order”).

The amendments made to the 2017 Order: insert definitions of “electric vehicle” and “non-electric vehicle”, and amend the definitions of “additional parking charge”, “parking place” and “permitted vehicle”, in article 3; amend Schedule 3, and substitute Map 4 in Schedule 1, to include Ballaughton Park Car Park as a parking area under the 2017 Order; amend the charges for using a parking place in an automatic number plate recognition – barrier controlled car park specified in Schedule 2 and a pay and display car park specified in Schedule 4, including introducing charges for parking in certain circumstances; and introduce a 3-month maximum stay in certain parking areas specified in Schedule 3.
