% Reductions comparing 2022/23 vs the baseline

- Fleet -9%
- Gas +10%
- Oil +11%
- Wood Chips -94%
- Electricity -45%
- Leased Buildings -2%
- Procurement -19%
- Waste -13%
- Staff Commuting -24%
- Water -82%
- Business Travel -36%

The Council's carbon footprint in 2022/23 was 15,534.8 TC02E which is an estimated 12% reduction from the baseline year (2018/19)

The Council measures emissions sources for fleet, gas, oil, wood chips, electricity, leased buildings, procurement, waste, staff commuting, water and business travel.



40 staff have engaged in the cycle to work scheme since it's launch

3 employees work from home on an arranged basis



17 employees have flexible working arrangements in place
